PETROLEUM PRODUCTION LICENCE(S) P.098, P.111 and P.672: JACKDAW FIELD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

I refer to the above-mentioned Petroleum Production Licence(s) and the potential field development mentioned above.

Subject to the necessary management and partner approvals, BG International Limited would intend to apply for Consent for the development of the said field, and this letter of application to provide preliminary notification of the proposals is made on behalf of:

BG International Limited (74%) and ONE-Dyas E&P Limited (26%).

The primary nature of this project will be for the phased development of the Jackdaw Gas Condensate Discovery and it is proposed this project will comprise of the following:

The Jackdaw Field is an undeveloped uHPHT gas condensate accumulation located in blocks 30/2a, 30/2d and 30/3a in the East Central Graben of the UK Central North Sea, approximately 275 km east of Aberdeen in 78m of water. It lies approximately 5 km from the UK-Norway median line.

The Jackdaw field will be developed through drilling of four wells through a Not Permanently Attended Well Head Platform tied back to the Shearwater Platform (30 km to the northwest) via a new pipeline. Gas will be exported via SEGAL (Shell Esso Gas Associated Liquids Line) and oil will be exported by FPS (Forties Pipeline System). The Shearwater Facility sits over and develops the Shearwater Field whilst also acting as a production hub for the Starling, Scoter, Merganser, Fram, Arran and Columbus Fields.

The Jackdaw Development aims to install the Well Head Jacket in 2021, followed by drilling of the four wells, pipeline and topsides installation to be ready of start up in the second half of 2023. Production life is expected to be around 7-8 years.

BG International Limited can confirm that an Environmental Statement ("ES") for the potential development will be submitted to the Environmental Management Team at the Offshore Petroleum Regulator for Environment and Decommissioning ("OPRED") in their capacity as environmental regulator acting on behalf of the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.
